SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a person shall not smoke in a motor vehicle containing a person under 18 years of age. Defines smoking as inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, weed, plant, regulated narcotic, or other combustible substance. Provides that a police officer may not stop a motor vehicle solely for a violation of this Section. Provides that a violation is a petty offense with a maximum fine of \$100.

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 11-1432 as follows:

Sec. 11-1432. Prohibit smoking in a motor vehicle with a
<u>minor present.</u>

9 (a) For purposes of this Section:

10 <u>"Smoke" means to inhale, exhale, burn, or carry a lighted</u>
11 <u>cigarette, cigar, pipe, weed, plant, regulated narcotic, or</u>
12 <u>other combustible substance.</u>

(b) A person shall not smoke in a motor vehicle if a person
under 18 years of age is in the motor vehicle.

18 (d) A violation of this Section is a petty offense with a
