SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/24-1.3 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Provides that it is unlawful for any person to possess a suppressor for any firearm that has had its serial number removed or altered. Provides that a violation is a Class 3 felony. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by adding
- 5 Section 24-1.3 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/24-1.3 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 24-1.3. Possession of a suppressor without a serial</u>
- 8 number or with an altered serial number.
- 9 (a) It is unlawful for any person to possess a suppressor
- 10 for any firearm that has had its serial number removed or
- 11 altered.
- 12 (b) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a Class 3
- 13 <u>felony</u>.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 15 becoming law.
