1 AN ACT concerning fish.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Fish and Aquatic Life Code is amended by changing Section 1-20 as follows:
- 6 (515 ILCS 5/1-20) (from Ch. 56, par. 1-20)
- 7 Sec. 1-20. Aquatic life. "Aquatic life" means all fish,
- 8 reptiles, amphibians, crayfish, and mussels. For the purposes
- 9 of Section 20-90, the definition of "aquatic life" shall
- 10 include, but is not limited to, all fish, reptiles, amphibians,
- 11 mollusks, crustaceans, algae, or other aquatic plants, and
- 12 aquatic invertebrates, and any other aquatic animals or plants
- 13 that the Department identifies in rules adopted after
- 14 consultation with biologists, zoologists, or other wildlife
- 15 <u>experts</u>.
