AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3440

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 3440 by replacing

3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Rural/Downstate Health Act is

5 amended by changing Section 5.5 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 65/5.5)

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7 Sec. 5.5. Rural/Downstate Health Access Fund.

8 <u>(a)</u> The Rural/Downstate Health Access Fund is created as a special fund in the State treasury. Moneys from <u>fees and</u> gifts,

10 grants, or donations made to the Center for Rural Health shall

11 be deposited into the Fund. Subject to appropriation <u>and except</u>

12 <u>as provided in subsection (b) of this Section</u>, moneys in the

Fund shall be used in the following manner for rural health

programs or for programs for the medically underserved

authorized under this Act: 60.2% shall be distributed to the

Department of Public Health, 26.3% shall be distributed to the

- 1 Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University, and 13.5%
- 2 shall be distributed to the Board of Trustees of the University
- 3 of Illinois.
- 4 (b) The Center for Rural Health at the Department of Public
- 5 Health may require that a J-1 Visa Waiver Program application
- 6 fee be collected from international medical graduates for the
- 7 purpose of administering the Program. J-1 Visa Waiver Program
- 8 application fees shall be deposited into the Rural/Downstate
- 9 Health Access Fund, shall be dedicated to the administration of
- 10 the J-1 Visa Waiver Program in Illinois, and may not be subject
- 11 to the distribution formula referenced in subsection (a) of
- 12 this Section.
- 13 (c) The Center for Rural Health shall administer the Fund.
- 14 (d) The Department shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 15 the provisions of this Section.
