Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Section
7-10.5 as follows:

Sec. 7-10.5. Petition validity. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, if a deviation from the requirements for petitions under this Code is minor or technical in nature and does not defeat the thrust, purpose, and effect of the Code or affect the intent to guarantee a fair and honest election, the defect in the petitions shall not render the petition invalid.
