## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

- 3 Section 60. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
- 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instructional
- 5 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to
- 6 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
- 7 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.
- 8 Section 65. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE GED Testing
- 10 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs
- 11 associated with administering GED tests.
- Section 70. The sum of \$5,725,000, or so much thereof as
- 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Community
- 14 College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois
- 15 Community College Board to be expended under the terms and
- 16 conditions associated with the moneys being received.
- 17 Section 75. The sum of \$480,000, or so much thereof as may
- 18 be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust
- 19 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and
- 20 contingency expenses of the Board.

- 1 Section 80. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
- 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Adult
- 3 Education Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for
- 4 operational expenses associated with administration of adult
- 5 education and literacy activities.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 7 2014.
