SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2310/2310-685 new

Amends the Department of Public Health Powers and Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Requires the Department of Public Health to establish and conduct a public education program to inform pregnant women and women who may become pregnant regarding cytomegalovirus.

(c) The Department shall provide the information described

| in subsection (b) of this Section to the following entities: |

| (3) any person offering health education in a school |
| district; |
| (4) health care providers offering care to pregnant |
| women and infants; and |
| (5) religious, ecclesiastical, or denominational |
| organizations offering children's programs as a part of |
| worship services. |
| (d) If a newborn infant fails a newborn hearing screening, |
| then the treating health care provider shall: |
| (1) test the newborn infant or refer the newborn infant |
| for testing for CMV before the newborn is 21 days of age, |
| unless a parent of the newborn infant objects; and |
| (2) provide to the parents of the newborn infant |
| information regarding (i) birth defects caused by |
| congenital CMV and (ii) available methods of treatment. |
