## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/31-4.6 new


#### Abstract

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Creates the offense of making a false statement to a peace officer or criminal investigative officer. Provides that a person commits the offense if: (1) the person knowingly makes a false statement to a peace officer or criminal investigative officer of the State or a unit of local government regarding a criminal matter that the person knows to be under investigation by the officer; and (2) during the interview, the person is first informed by a prosecutor who is working with the officer on the investigation that a knowing false statement to the officer relating to the investigation would constitute a criminal offense. Provides that a violation is a Class 4 felony.

## A BILL FOR

AN ACT concerning criminal law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by adding Section 31-4.6 as follows:
(720 ILCS 5/31-4.6 new)
Sec. 31-4.6. Making a false statement to a peace officer or criminal investigative officer.
(a) A person commits making a false statement to a peace officer or criminal investigative officer if:
(1) the person knowingly makes a false statement to a peace officer or criminal investigative officer of this State or a unit of local government regarding a criminal matter that the person knows to be under investigation by the officer; and
(2) during the interview, the person is first informed by a prosecutor who is working with the officer on the investigation that a knowing false statement to the officer relating to the investigation would constitute a criminal offense.
(b) Sentence. Making a false statement to a peace officer or criminal investigative officer is a Class 4 felony.
