**A BILL FOR**

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Hearing Instrument Consumer Protection Act  
5 is amended by changing Section 25 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 50/25) (from Ch. 111, par. 7425)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2016)

8 Sec. 25. Any circuit court may, upon application of the ~~the~~  
9 prosecutor or of the applicant or licensee against whom  
10 disciplinary proceedings are pending, enter an order requiring  
11 the attendance of witnesses and their testimony, and the  
12 production of documents, papers, files, books and records in  
13 connection with any hearing or investigation. The court may  
14 compel obedience to its order by proceedings for contempt.
