## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Hearing Instrument Consumer Protection Act
- 5 is amended by changing Section 25 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 50/25) (from Ch. 111, par. 7425)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2016)
- 8 Sec. 25. Any circuit court may, upon application of  $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 9 prosecutor or of the applicant or licensee against whom
- 10 disciplinary proceedings are pending, enter an order requiring
- 11 the attendance of witnesses and their testimony, and the
- 12 production of documents, papers, files, books and records in
- 13 connection with any hearing or investigation. The court may
- compel obedience to its order by proceedings for contempt.
