Amends the Unified Code of Corrections. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the definition of "imprisonment".

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by
5 changing Section 5-1-10 as follows:

6 (730 ILCS 5/5-1-10) (from Ch. 38, par. 1005-1-10)

7 Sec. 5-1-10. Imprisonment. "Imprisonment" means
8 incarceration in a correctional institution under a sentence of
9 imprisonment and ~~and~~ does not include "periodic imprisonment"
10 under Article 7. "Imprisonment" also includes electronic home
11 detention served by an offender after (i) the offender has been
12 committed to the custody of the sheriff to serve the sentence
13 and (ii) the sheriff has placed the offender in an electronic
14 home detention program in accordance with Article 8A of Chapter
15 V of this Code.
