2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Professional Regulation Law of
the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding
Section 2105-170 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 2105/2105-170 new)

Sec. 2105-170. Health care workers; automatic suspension 8 9 of license. A health care worker, as defined by the Health Care Worker Self-Referral Act, licensed by the Department shall be 10 automatically and indefinitely suspended at such time as the 11 final trial proceedings are concluded whereby a licensee has 12 been either convicted of, or has entered a plea of guilty or 13 14 nolo contendere in a criminal prosecution to, a criminal health care or criminal insurance fraud offense, requiring intent, 15 under the laws of the State, the laws of any other state, or 16 17 the laws of the United States of America, including, but not limited to, criminal Medicare or Medicaid fraud. A certified 18 19 copy of the conviction or judgment shall be the basis for the 20 suspension. If a licensee requests a hearing, then the sole 21 purpose of the hearing shall be limited to the length of the 22 suspension of the licensee's license, as the conviction or judgment is a matter of record and may not be challenged. 23
