SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-806.3

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806.3

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Increases the list of special registration plates that any vehicle owner, or spouse of the vehicle owner, who has been approved for benefits under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief Act, may receive a discounted registration fee upon purchase of the designated plate.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 3-806.3 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806.3) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806.3)

7 Sec. 3-806.3. Senior Citizens. Commencing with the 2009
8 registration year, the registration fee paid by any vehicle
9 owner who has been approved for benefits under the Senior
10 Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief Act or who is
11 the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee
12 otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying
13 standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section
14 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates
15 issued under Section 3-609, 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624,
16 3-625, 3-626, 3-627, 3-628, 3-630, 3-634, 3-638, 3-642, 3-643,
17 3-645, 3-646, 3-647, 3-648, 3-650, 3-651, 3-653, 3-657, 3-661,
18 ~~or~~ 3-663, 3-665, 3-670, 3-675, 3-678, 3-679, 3-689, 3-697,
19 3-699.4, 3-699.6, or 3-699.13, motor vehicles displaying
20 America Remembers, Prevent Violence, or Saluting Agriculture
21 special registration plates, motor vehicles registered at
22 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a), and recreational
23 vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section

1 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be
2 entitled to this reduced registration fee for the registration
3 year in which the claimant was eligible.

4 Commencing with the 2009 registration year, the
5 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and
6 received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons
7 Property Tax Relief Act or who is the spouse of such a person
8 shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code
9 for passenger cars displaying standard multi-year registration
10 plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying
11 special registration plates issued under Section 3-607, 3-609,
12 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-627, 3-628,
13 3-638, 3-630, 3-634, 3-642, 3-643, 3-645, 3-646, 3-647, 3-648,
14 3-650, 3-651, 3-653, 3-657, 3-661, 3-663, ~~or~~ 3-664, 3-665,
15 3-670, 3-675, 3-678, 3-679, 3-689, 3-697, 3-699.4, 3-699.6, or
16 3-699.13, motor vehicles displaying America Remembers, Prevent
17 Violence, or Saluting Agriculture special registration plates,
18 motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section
19 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds
20 or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of
21 claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration
22 fee for the registration year in which the claimant was
23 eligible.

24 No more than one reduced registration fee under this
25 Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on
26 the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such reduced

1 registration fee is allowed to the individual or to the spouse,
2 widow or widower of such individual. This Section does not
3 apply to the fee paid in addition to the registration fee for
4 motor vehicles displaying vanity or special license plates.
