# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The following amount, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary for objects and purposes hereinafter named, 4 are appropriated from the Drug Traffic Prevention Fund to the 5 Department of State Police, Division of Operations, pursuant 6 to the provisions of the "Intergovernmental Drug Laws 7 Enforcement Act" for Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement 8 Groups.

8 Section 75. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police 10 Streetgang-Related Crime Fund to the Department of State 11 Police for operations related to streetgang-related Crime 12 Initiatives.

Section 80. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Over-Dimensional Load Police Escort Fund to the Department of State Police for expenses incurred for providing police escorts for overdimensional loads.

19 Section 100. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of 21 State Police from the State Police Firearm Services Fund for 22 expenses as outlined in the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and HB2900 -10- OMB099 00045 LEH 20045 b the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act.

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2 Section 105. The sum of \$2,013,600, or so much thereof 3 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of 4 State Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless 5 Service Emergency Fund for expenses incurred for the 6 Statewide 911 Administrator Program.

7 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July8 1, 2015.
