SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, as follows:

General Funds	\$	17,013,400
Other State Funds	\$	20,796,500
Federal Funds	\$	65,047,300
Total	\$ 3	102,857,200

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

Section 1. "Operational expenses" defined. For the 5 purposes of this Act, the term "operational expenses" 6 7 includes the following items: 8 (a) Personal Services; 9 (b) State contributions to Social Security (c) Group Insurances; 10 (d) Contractual Services 11 12 (e) Travel; 13 (f) Commodities; 14 (g) Printing; 15 (h) Equipment; (i) Electronic data processing; 16 17 (j) Telecommunications services;

(m) Employee retirement contributions paid by the employer;

(k) Operation of automotive equipment;

(n) Permanent improvements;

(o) Deposits to other funds.

- 1 Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated,
- 2 the amount of \$1,951,200, or so much thereof as may be
- 3 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 4 the Criminal Justice Information Authority for operational
- 5 expenses, awards, grants and permanent improvements for the
- 6 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.
- 7 Section 10. The sum of \$10,750,000, or so much thereof
- 8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 9 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
- 10 for administrative costs, awards and grants for the Adult
- 11 Redeploy Programs.
- 12 Section 15. The amount of \$528,300, or so much thereof
- as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 14 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
- 15 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council
- 16 Program.
- 17 Section 20. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
- 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 19 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
- 20 for the purpose of awarding grants, contracts, administrative
- 21 expenses and all related costs for the Safe From the Start

- 1 Program.
- 2 Section 25. The amount of \$1,949,000, or so much thereof
- 3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 4 Fund to Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
- 5 grants and administrative expenses related to Operation
- 6 CeaseFire.
- 7 Section 30. The amount of \$634,900, or so much thereof
- 8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 9 Fund to Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority for
- 10 operational expenses and awards in support of Federal
- 11 Assistance Programs administered by the State and Local
- 12 Governments and Non-Profit Organizations.
- 13 Section 35. The sum of \$42,500,000, or so much thereof
- 14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
- 15 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
- 16 Information Authority for awards and grants to local units of
- 17 government and non-profit organizations.
- 18 Section 40. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
- 19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Criminal
- 20 Justice Trust Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice
- 21 Information Authority for awards and grants to state

1 agencies.

2	Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof
3	as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
4	Criminal Justice Information Authority for activities
5	undertaken in support of federal assistance programs
6	administered by units of state and local government and non-
7	profit organizations:
8	Payable from the Criminal Justice
9	Trust Fund
10	Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much
11	thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois
12	Criminal Justice Information Authority for awards and grants
13	and other monies received from federal agencies, from other
14	units of government, and from private/not-for-profit
15	organizations for activities undertaken in support of
16	investigating issues in criminal justice and for undertaking
17	other criminal justice information projects:
