Makes specified appropriations and reappropriations to the General Assembly and the Legislative Ethics Commission for their FY16 ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2015.

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The sum of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 5 6 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 7 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 8 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of 9 their respective houses throughout the year in connection 10 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in 11 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law. 12 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of 13 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated 14 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

Section 10. Payments from the sums appropriated in Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case may be.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$20,603,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet 2 ordinary and incidental expenses 3 of the legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and 4 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general 5 6 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 25.7% appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 7 expenditures, 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate Minority 8 9 Leader for such expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the 10 Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 23.8% 11 to the House Minority Leader for appropriated 12 expenditures.

Section 20. The sum of \$9,882,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of committees, the general staff and operations, per diem employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount, 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

Section 25. The sum of \$309,200, or so much thereof as

may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses, also including the purchasing on contract as required by law of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723% is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such

14 Section 30. The sum of \$6,483,050, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to 16 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees 17 expert witnesses, technical services, consulting 18 assistance and other research assistance associated with 19 special studies and long range research projects which may be 20 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the 21 House of Representatives for Standing House Committees 22 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 23 Of this amount, 46.862% is appropriated to President of the Senate for such expenditures and 53.138% is 24

- 2 expenditures.
- Section 35. The sum of \$167,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to 4 5 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for allowances for the particular and additional services 6 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the 7 8 Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President 9 of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated 10 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures.
- 11 Section 40. The sum of \$88,100, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 13 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 14 Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield 15 of members on official legislative business during weeks when 16 the General Assembly is not in Session. Of this amount, 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such 17 18 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the 19 House for such expenditures.
- Section 45. The sum of \$341,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent

- 1 expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section
- 2 must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of
- 3 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.
- Section 50. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where 4 5 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives is expressly required for the expenditure of or the incurring 6 7 of indebtedness against an appropriation for certain 8 purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of the 9 party having the largest number of members of the House of 10 Representatives as of January 14, 2015, and "Minority Leader" means the leader of the party having the second largest 11 12 number of members of the House of Representatives as of 13 January 14, 2015.
- Section 55. The sum of \$312,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector General.
- Section 60. The sum of \$113,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Senate Operations Commission including the planning costs, construction costs, moving

- 1 expenses and all other costs associated with the construction
- 2 and reconstruction of Senate offices in the Capitol Complex
- 3 area.
- 4 Section 65. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
- 5 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the
- 6 General Assembly Operations Revolving Fund to the President
- 7 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
- 8 to meet ordinary and contingent expenses. Of this amount,
- 9 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
- 10 expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
- 11 House for such expenditures.
- 12 Section 70. The following named sums, or so much thereof
- 13 as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an
- 14 appropriation hereto made for such purposes in Section 70 of
- 15 Article 21 of Public Act 98-0679, as amended, are re-
- 16 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund for expenses in
- 17 connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting
- of Legislative and Representative Districts as required by
- 19 Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970:

2	as may be necessary and remain unexpended from an
3	appropriation hereto made for such purposes in Section 75 of
4	Article 21 of Public Act 98-0679, as amended, are re-
5	appropriated from the General Revenue Fund for expenses in
6	connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting
7	of Legislative and Representative Districts as required by
8	Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970:

10	To the House Minority Leader500,000

Section 80. The sum of \$441,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Section 80 of Article 21 of Public Act 98-0679, as amended, is reappropriated to the Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative and representative districts as required by Article IV, Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution on 1970.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 21 1, 2015.
