

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Section 5.866 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.866 new)

7 Sec. 5.866. The Emergency Management Fund.

8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
9 Section 3-699.14 as follows:

10 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14 new)

11 Sec. 3-699.14. Emergency Management plates.

12 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
13 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
14 issue special registration plates designated as Emergency
15 Management license plates. The special plates issued under this
16 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the
17 first division or motor vehicles of the second division
18 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this
19 Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure
20 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

21 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be

1 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate
2 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany
3 each application.

4 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a
5 \$20 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate
6 registration fee. Of this fee, \$5 shall be deposited into the
7 Emergency Management Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into the
8 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used by
9 the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing
10 costs. For each registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in
11 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.
12 Of this fee, \$18 shall be deposited into the Emergency
13 Management Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of
14 State Special License Plate Fund.

15 (d) The Emergency Management Fund is created as a special
16 fund in the State treasury. All money in the Emergency
17 Management Fund shall be paid, subject to appropriation by the
18 General Assembly and distribution by the Secretary, as grants
19 to The Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of
20 providing training and education programs.
