SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/27-22.3

from Ch. 122, par. 27-22.3

Amends the School Code. Requires (instead of permits) a school district to establish a volunteer service credit program. Provides that the program shall enable secondary school students to earn credit through completion of 75 hours of community service as a requirement for graduation (instead of to earn credit towards graduation through performance of community service). Makes related changes. Requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules (instead of school districts). Effective immediately.

STATE MANDATES ACT MAY REQUIRE REIMBURSEMENT

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1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 5 27-22.3 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/27-22.3) (from Ch. 122, par. 27-22.3)
- 7 Sec. 27-22.3. Volunteer service credit program.
- (a) A school district shall may establish a volunteer 8 9 service credit program that enables secondary school students credit towards graduation through 10 completion performance of 75 hours of community service as a requirement 11 community service 12 for graduation. This may include participation in the organization of a high school or community 13 14 blood drive or other blood donor recruitment campaign. Any program so established shall begin with students entering grade 15 16 9 in the <u>2015-2016</u> 1993 1994 school year or later. The amount 17 of credit given for program participation shall not exceed that 18 given for completion of one semester of language arts, math, 19 science or social studies.
 - (b) Any community service performed as part of a course for which credit is given towards graduation shall not qualify under a volunteer service credit program. Any service for which a student is paid shall not qualify under a volunteer service

- 1 credit program. Any community work assigned as a disciplinary
- 2 measure shall not qualify under a volunteer service credit
- 3 program.
- 4 (c) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to
- 5 implement this Section. School districts that establish
- 6 volunteer service credit programs shall establish any
- 7 necessary rules, regulations and procedures.
