

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much of those
6 amounts as may be necessary, are appropriated for General
7 State Aid to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
8 purposes as approximated below:

9	Payable from the Education Assistance Fund.....	401,223,700
10	Payable from the Common School Fund.....	3,611,012,300
11	Payable from the General Revenue Fund.....	173,952,200
12	Payable from the Fund for the Advancement	
13	of Education:	446,000,000

14 Section 10. The amount of \$85,000,000 is appropriated
15 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of
16 Education to provide a supplemental grant to entities that
17 receive General State Aid to limit the loss per student due
18 to the difference between the General State Aid claim as
19 calculated pursuant to Section 18-8.05 and the amount
20 appropriated for purposes of Section 18-8.05 divided by the
21 Average Daily Attendance as defined in subsection (C)(2) of

1 Section 18-8.05. This supplemental grant shall be paid first
 2 to the entity with the greatest loss per student, and then to
 3 the next entity with the greatest loss per student until
 4 losses per student are reduced to their smallest possible
 5 amount given this appropriation.

6 Section 15. The following amounts or so much thereof as
 7 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State
 8 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and
 9 not, under any circumstances, for personal services
 10 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs,
 11 are appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for
 12 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015:

4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
5 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for the
6 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Southwest Organizing
7 Project Parent Mentoring Program.

8 ARTICLE 2

9 Section 5. The following amounts or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, which shall be used by the Illinois State
11 Board of Education exclusively for the foregoing purposes and
12 not, under any circumstances, for personal services
13 expenditures or other operational or administrative costs,
14 are appropriated to the Illinois State Board of Education for
15 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015:

17 Section 15. In addition to any other amounts
 18 appropriated for such purposes, the following named amounts,
 19 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from

 22 Illinois State Board of Education for the fiscal year
 23 beginning July 1, 2015:

2 Section 20. The amount of \$600,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the School
4 Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education
5 for its ordinary and contingent expenses.

6 Section 25. The amount of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Temporary
8 Relocation Expenses Revolving Grant Fund for use by the State
9 Board of Education as provided in Section 2-3.77 of the
10 School Code.

11 Section 30. The amount of \$2,208,900, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISBE Teacher
13 Certificate Institute Fund to the Illinois State Board of
14 Education for Teacher Certificates.

15 Section 35. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Teacher
17 Certificate Fee Revolving Fund to the Illinois State Board of
18 Education for Teacher Mentoring Programs.

19 Section 40. The amount of \$8,484,800, or so much of that
20 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State

1 Board of Education Special Purpose Trust Fund to the State
2 Board of Education for expenditures by the Board in
3 accordance with grants, gifts or donations that the Board has
4 received or may receive from any source, public or private,
5 in support of projects that are within the lawful powers of
6 the Board.

7 Section 45. The amount of \$200,000, or so much of that
8 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the After-
9 School Rescue Fund to the State Board of Education for its
10 ordinary and contingent expenses.

11 Section 50. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SBE Federal
13 Department of Education Fund to the Illinois State Board of
14 Education for all costs associated with related activities
15 for the Early Learning Challenge for the fiscal year
16 beginning July 1, 2015.

17 ARTICLE 3

18 Section 5. The sum of \$3,741,702,194, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School
20 Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of
21 Illinois for the State's contribution, as provided by law.

1 Section 10. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
3 Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the
4 State of Illinois for additional costs due to the
5 establishment of minimum retirement allowances pursuant to
6 Sections 16-136.2 and 16-136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code,
7 as amended.

8 Section 15. The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund
10 to the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer
11 contributions required by the State as an employer of
12 teachers described under subsection (e) of Section 16-158 of
13 the Illinois Pension Code.

14 Section 20. The amount of \$12,105,000, or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
16 Revenue Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and
17 Retirement Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for
18 retirement contributions under Section 17-127 of the Illinois
19 Pension Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015.

20 Section 25. The amount of \$108,258,261, or so much
21 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the

1 Education Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System
2 of the State of Illinois for deposit into the Teacher Health
3 Insurance Security Fund as the state's contribution for
4 teachers' health insurance.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund
7 to the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer
8 contributions required by the State as an employer of
9 teachers described under subsection (f) of Section 16-158 of
10 the Illinois Pension Code.
