#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.866 new  
625 ILCS 5/3-699.14 new

Amends the State Finance Act. Creates the Chicago Public Schools Special License Plate Fund as a special fund in the State treasury. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code to provide for the issuance of Chicago Public Schools license plates. Provides that the design and color of the special plates shall be determined by a contest that every elementary school pupil attending a Chicago public school is eligible to enter, and the winning design shall be selected by a committee. Establishes membership of the committee. Provides that the applicant shall pay an additional fee of \$40 for original issuance of the plates, of which \$25 shall be deposited into the Chicago Public Schools Special License Plate Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that an additional fee of \$40 shall be charged for each renewal, of which \$38 shall be deposited into the Chicago Public Schools Special License Plate Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that money in the Chicago Public Schools Special License Plate Fund shall be paid as grants to the City of Chicago, on an annual basis, to be used in funding Chicago public schools. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 5.866 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.866 new)

7 Sec. 5.866. The Chicago Public Schools Special License  
8 Plate Fund.

9 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding  
10 Section 3-699.14 as follows:

11 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14 new)

12 Sec. 3-699.14. Chicago Public Schools license plates.

13 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and  
14 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of  
15 State, may issue special registration plates designated as  
16 Chicago Public Schools license plates. The special plates  
17 issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger  
18 vehicles of the first division or motor vehicles of the second  
19 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued  
20 under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year  
21 procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

1       (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be  
2 determined by a contest that every elementary school pupil  
3 attending a Chicago public school is eligible to enter. The  
4 designs submitted for the contest shall be judged on September  
5 30, 2015, and the winning design shall be selected by a  
6 committee. The committee shall be composed of the Secretary,  
7 the Director of State Police, the Mayor of the City of Chicago,  
8 2 members of the Senate with one member appointed by the  
9 President of the Senate and one member appointed by the Senate  
10 Minority Leader, and 2 members of the House of Representatives  
11 with one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
12 Representatives and one member appointed by the House of  
13 Representatives Minority Leader. The plates are not required to  
14 designate "Land of Lincoln" as prescribed in subsection (b) of  
15 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary may allow the plates  
16 to be issued as vanity or personalized plates under Section  
17 3-405.1 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers or  
18 decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code.  
19 Appropriate documentation, as determined by the Secretary,  
20 shall accompany each application.

21       (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$40 fee for original  
22 issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee, if  
23 applicable. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the  
24 Chicago Public Schools Special License Plate Fund and \$15 shall  
25 be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate  
26 Fund. For each registration renewal period, a \$40 fee, in

1 addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged.  
2 Of this fee, \$38 shall be deposited into the Chicago Public  
3 Schools Special License Plate Fund and \$2 shall be deposited  
4 into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

5 (d) The Chicago Public Schools Special License Plate Fund  
6 is created as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys  
7 in the Chicago Public Schools Special License Plate Fund shall  
8 be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and  
9 distribution by the Secretary, as grants to the City of  
10 Chicago, on an annual basis, to be used in funding Chicago  
11 public schools.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
13 becoming law.
