1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3932

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 3932 on page 6, line  
3 9, after "undertaken.", by inserting "In all other cases, the  
4 Public Access Counselor shall forward a copy of the request for  
5 review to the campus police department within 7 business days  
6 after receipt and shall specify the records or other documents  
7 that the campus police department shall furnish to facilitate  
8 the review. Within 7 business days after receipt of the request  
9 for review, the campus police department shall provide copies  
10 of records requested and shall otherwise fully cooperate with  
11 the Public Access Counselor. If a campus police department  
12 fails to furnish specified records pursuant to this Section or  
13 if otherwise necessary, the Attorney General may issue a  
14 subpoena to any person or campus police department having  
15 knowledge of or records pertaining to a request for review of a  
16 denial of access to records under this Section. To the extent  
17 that records or documents produced by a campus police  
18 department contain information that is claimed to be exempt

1 from disclosure, the public access counselor shall not further  
2 disclose that information."; and

3 on page 7, line 5, after "County.", by inserting "If (1) the  
4 Public Access Counselor determines that the alleged violation  
5 is unfounded within 180 days after receipt of the request for  
6 review or (2) the Attorney General chooses to resolve the  
7 request for review by means other than the issuance of a  
8 binding opinion within 180 days after receipt of the request  
9 for review by the Public Access Counselor, then, within 30 days  
10 after the Public Access Counselor's or Attorney General's  
11 action, the requester may file suit for injunctive or  
12 declaratory relief in the circuit court for the county where  
13 the campus police department is located. If no binding opinion  
14 is issued within 180 days after receipt of the request for  
15 review by the Public Access Counselor, then the requester may  
16 alternatively file suit for injunctive or declaratory relief in  
17 the circuit court for the county where the campus police  
18 department is located."
