14 Section 5. The sum of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the 16 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 17 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section 18 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of 19 their respective houses throughout the year in connection 20 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in 21 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law. 22 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of

Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to 20 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723% 21 is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such 22 expenditures.

Section 30. The sum of \$6,483,050, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to President of the Senate for the use of standing committees 2 witnesses, technical 3 expert services, consulting assistance and other research assistance associated with 4 special studies and long range research projects which may be 5 6 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for Standing House Committees 7 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of 8 9 1984. Of this amount, 46.862% is appropriated to 10 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 53.138% is 11 to the Speaker of the House appropriated for 12 expenditures.
