Amends the State Designations Act. Provides that the Kankakee Mallow is designated the native State flower (currently, the native violet). Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Designations Act is amended by
5 changing Section 40 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 460/40) (from Ch. 1, par. 2901-40)

7 Sec. 40. State tree and flower. The white oak tree is
8 designated the native State tree of the State of Illinois; and
9 the Kankakee mallow ~~native violet~~ is designated the native
10 State flower of the State of Illinois.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
13 becoming law.
