1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's
5 Act is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 210/8) (from Ch. 14, par. 208)

7 Sec. 8. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to
8 abrogate or diminish the ~~the~~ rights of State's Attorneys to
9 prosecute appeals in any case.
