SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-806

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a \$3 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the current annual registration fee for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles, motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles. Provides that the money collected shall be deposited into the Fire Prevention Fund for the maintenance, operation, and capital expenses of the Mutual Aid Box Alarm System.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-806 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806) 7 Sec. 3-806. Registration Fees; Motor Vehicles of the First Division. Every owner of any other motor vehicle of the first 8 9 division, except as provided in Sections 3-804, 3-804.01, 3-804.3, 3-805, 3-806.3, 3-806.7, and 3-808, and every second 10 division vehicle weighing 8,000 pounds or less, shall pay the 11 Secretary of State an annual registration fee at the following 12 13 rates:

2 Motorcycles, Motor Driven

3 Cycles and Pedalcycles

A \$1 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles, motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles to be deposited into the State Police Vehicle Fund.

8 All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by 9 Public Act 96-34 shall be deposited into the Capital Projects 10 Fund.

A \$2 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above 11 12 fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles, motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles to be 13 deposited into the Park and Conservation Fund for the 14 Department of Natural Resources to use for conservation 15 16 efforts. The monies deposited into the Park and Conservation 17 Fund under this Section shall not be subject to administrative 18 charges or chargebacks unless otherwise authorized by this Act. A \$3 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above 19 20 fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles, 21 motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles to be

22 <u>deposited into the Fire Prevention Fund for the maintenance,</u>
23 <u>operation, and capital expenses of the Mutual Aid Box Alarm</u>
24 System (MABAS).
