SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/5

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that veterans of the United States Armed Forces who were discharged honorably will be exempt from the \$10 Firearm Owner's Identification Card application fee.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
 amended by changing Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 65/5) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-5)

7 Sec. 5. The Department of State Police shall either approve 8 or deny all applications within 30 days from the date they are 9 received, and every applicant found qualified under Section 8 of this Act by the Department shall be entitled to a Firearm 10 Owner's Identification Card upon the payment of a \$10 fee. Any 11 applicant who is an active duty member of the Armed Forces of 12 13 the United States, a member of the Illinois National Guard, or 14 a member of the Reserve Forces of the United States, or a Veteran of the United States Armed Forces, who has been 15 16 discharged honorably, is exempt from the application fee. \$6 of each fee derived from the issuance of Firearm Owner's 17 Identification Cards, or renewals thereof, shall be deposited 18 19 in the Wildlife and Fish Fund in the State Treasury; \$1 of the 20 fee shall be deposited in the State Police Services Fund and \$3 21 of the fee shall be deposited in the State Police Firearm 22 Services Fund.
