2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 6167 as follows:

3 on page 1, lines 4 and 5, by replacing "Section 5-8.5" with  
4 "Sections 4-8.5, 5-8.5, and 6-35.5"; and

5 on page 1, immediately below line 5, by inserting the  
6 following:

7 "(10 ILCS 5/4-8.5 new)

8 Sec. 4-8.5. Deputy registrar eligibility;  
9 pre-registration. Unless otherwise provided by law, an  
10 individual that is 17 years old or older who is registered to  
11 vote in this State shall be eligible to serve as a deputy  
12 registrar. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
13 contrary, an individual who will be 18 years of age or older at  
14 the next general election may sign and circulate candidate  
15 petitions and may pre-register to vote, and shall be deemed

1 competent to execute and attest to any voter registration  
2 forms, with the registration held in abeyance by the  
3 appropriate election authority until such time as that  
4 individual attains the required age to vote."; and

5 on page 1, line 14, by replacing "register" with  
6 "pre-register"; and

7 on page 1, immediately below line 18, by inserting the  
8 following:

9 " (10 ILCS 5/6-35.5 new)

10 Sec. 6-35.5. Deputy registrar eligibility;  
11 pre-registration. Unless otherwise provided by law, an  
12 individual that is 17 years old or older who is registered to  
13 vote in this State shall be eligible to serve as a deputy  
14 registrar. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
15 contrary, an individual who will be 18 years of age or older at  
16 the next general election may sign and circulate candidate  
17 petitions and may pre-register to vote, and shall be deemed  
18 competent to execute and attest to any voter registration  
19 forms, with the registration held in abeyance by the  
20 appropriate election authority until such time as that  
21 individual attains the required age to vote.".
