1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1 Section 1. The sum of \$9,029,800, or so much thereof as 5 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 7 Fund to the Department of Human Rights for operational expenses of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017. 8 The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 9 Section 5. 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Human Rights Training and Development Fund to the Department 11 12 of Human Rights for the purpose of funding expenses associated with administration. 13 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof 14 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the 15 16 Special Projects Division Fund: 17 18 For State Contributions to State 19

- 9 Section 15. The sum of \$978,200, or so much thereof as
 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 11 Fund to the Department of Human Rights for expenses relating
 12 to the investigation and processing of human rights cases,
 13 and expenses associated with Elementary and Higher Education
 14 processing.
- Section 20. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Human Rights Special Fund to the Department of Human Rights for the purpose of funding expenses associated with the Department of Human Rights.
- Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced

1 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
