### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Reappropriates \$14,189,699 to the Department of Natural Resources from the Abandoned Mined Lands Reclamation Council Federal Trust Fund for grants and contracts to conduct research, planning, and construction to eliminate hazards created by abandoned mines, and any other expenses necessary for emergency response. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$14,189,699, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of  
6 business on June 30, 2015, from appropriations heretofore  
7 made in Article 7, Section 170 of Public Act 98-0675 and  
8 Article 8, Section 255, of Public Act 98-0675, as amended, is  
9 reappropriated to the Department of Natural Resources from  
10 the Abandoned Mined Lands Reclamation Council Federal Trust  
11 Fund for grants and contracts to conduct research, planning,  
12 and construction to eliminate hazards created by abandoned  
13 mines, and any other expenses necessary for emergency  
14 response.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
16 becoming law.
