HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of James C. 4 Craven of Bellingham, Washington, who passed away on January 5 12, 2015; and

6 WHEREAS, James Craven was born in Greenfield, Tennessee on 7 August 7, 1925 to Arlie and Addie Craven; his family moved to 8 Chicago in the 1930s; he graduated from Lakeview High School, 9 the University of Illinois, and the University of Illinois Law 10 School; he served in the United States Army during World War 11 II; he married Gloria Pheney in November of 1950; and

12 WHEREAS, James Craven, along with his wife, started a law 13 practice in Springfield; he practiced law in Springfield until 14 1964, when he was elected to the Fourth District Appellate Court; he served until 1981, when he resigned from the court 15 and resumed his law practice in Springfield; he began the 16 practice of offering legal help to students in the Public 17 Affairs Reporting Program at the University of Illinois at 18 19 Springfield and to reporters and editors through the Illinois 20 Press Association and Illinois Broadcasters' Association, which continue to this day; and 21

WHEREAS, James Craven also involved himself in many other

-2-LRB099 08587 MST 28748 r cases and legislative matters involving First 1 Amendment 2 issues; in the early 1990s, the Press Association honored him 3 with the creation and presentation of the James C. Craven First Amendment Award; the highlight of his legal work began in 1985, 4 5 with the filing of the first of many cases he filed on behalf of the African American and Hispanic communities in Illinois 6 7 and California under the federal Voting Rights Act; these 8 lawsuits resulted in changes in the form of municipal and 9 special district governments in Springfield, Danville, Peoria 10 and Chicago Heights, which are designed to provide minority 11 voters with the opportunity to elect representatives of their 12 choice; and

WHEREAS, James Craven is survived by his wife, Gloria; his 13 4 children, William (Terri Tork), Nancy (Jim Claypool), Don 14 15 (Denise), and Rebecca (Scott Linneman); and his 6 16 grandchildren, Joseph and David Craven, Anna and Meg Claypool, and Charlie and Dory Linneman; therefore, be it 17
