## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Brigadier General Richard J. Hayes, Jr. of Chatham 3 has been appointed by Governor Bruce Rauner to the 4 distinguished position of Adjutant General of the Illinois 5 National Guard; and

6 WHEREAS, General Hayes was commissioned in 1987 from the 7 Reserve Officer Training Corps program at the University of 8 Kansas as a field artillery officer; he has served nearly 25 9 years with the Illinois National Guard; and

10 WHEREAS, General Hayes held several previous positions in the Illinois National Guard, including battery commander with 11 Battery C, 2nd Battalion, 122nd Field Artillery in Chicago; 12 13 commander of 2nd Battalion, 122nd Field Artillery, also in 14 Chicago; commander of Task Force 122 in New Orleans, Louisiana, 15 during Hurricane Katrina and Rita Relief Operations; assistant chief of staff G3 for the 35th Infantry Division; deputy 16 17 commander of Task Force Falcon in Kosovo, Serbia; director of operations J3 for Joint Force Headquarters in Springfield; and 18 19 commander of the 129th Regiment (Regional Training Institute) 20 also in Springfield; and

21 WHEREAS, General Hayes' professional military education 22 includes the Field Artillery Officer Basic and Advanced

HR0568 -2-LRB099 12646 MST 36303 r 1 Courses, Command and General Staff College, U.S. Army War College, the Joint Task Force Commander Training Course, and 2 3 the Contingency Dual Status Commander Qualification Program; he holds a bachelor's degree in geography from the University 4 5 of Kansas, a master's degree in business administration from Touro University International, and a master's degree in 6 7 strategic studies from the U.S. Army War College; additionally, 8 General Hayes spent 27 years working in engineering and 9 construction, including as CEO of a civil construction firm 10 based in Addison; and

11 WHEREAS, General Hayes' military awards and decorations 12 the Legion of Merit (1 Oak Leaf Cluster), include the Meritorious Service Medal (2 Bronze Oak Leaf Clusters), the 13 14 Army Commendation Medal (1 Silver Oak Leaf Cluster and 1 Bronze 15 Oak Leaf Cluster), the Army Achievement Medal, the Army Reserve 16 Component Achievement Medal (1 Silver Oak Leaf Cluster), the National Defense Service Medal (1 Bronze Service Star), the 17 Humanitarian Service Medal (1 Bronze Service Star), the Kosovo 18 19 Campaign Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the 20 Armed Forces Reserve Medal ("M" device and Silver Hour Glass), 21 the Army Service Ribbon, the Overseas Service Ribbon, the Army 22 Reserve Components Overseas Training Ribbon, and the Non-Article 5 NATO Medal; therefore, be it 23
