WHEREAS, Dr. Schroeder attended Saint Viator High School in Arlington Heights; he then attended the University of Notre Dame and the University of Illinois School of Dentistry; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Schroeder was a dentist for 36 years; he had a thriving dental practice in the heart of Arlington Heights, serving patients of all ages throughout the northwest suburbs; and
