SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/6-901

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes an addition to the definition of a "medical examiner" or "medical practitioner" to include a licensed optometrist for the purpose of certifying vision fitness to operate a motor vehicle.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 6-901 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/6-901) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 6-901)
- 7 Sec. 6-901. Definitions. For the purposes of this Article:
- 8 "Board" means the Driver's License Medical Advisory Board.
- 9 "Medical examiner" or "medical practitioner" means:
- 10 (i) any person licensed to practice medicine in all its
 11 branches in the State of Illinois or any other state;
- 12 (ii) a licensed physician assistant who has been 13 delegated the performance of medical examinations by his or 14 her supervising physician; or
 - (iii) a licensed advanced practice nurse who has a written collaborative agreement with a collaborating physician which authorizes him or her to perform medical examinations; or \div
- 19 <u>(iv) a licensed optometrist for the purpose of</u>
 20 <u>certifying vision fitness to operate a motor vehicle.</u>
