1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

Section 5. The sum of \$397,073,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program, as provided by law, and for agency administrative and operational costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total appropriation in this Section.

Section 10. The sum of \$274,601,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for distribution of base operating and equalization grants to qualifying public community colleges and the City Colleges of Chicago for educational related expenses.
