1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2157

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2157 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Public Community College Act is amended by
5 adding Section 3-8.5 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 805/3-8.5 new)

7 Sec. 3-8.5. Community college trustee's leadership
8 training.

9 (a) This Section applies to all community college districts
10 with elected or appointed board trustees serving pursuant to
11 this Article who have been elected or appointed after the
12 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 99th General
13 Assembly or appointed to fill a vacancy of at least one year's
14 duration of an elected trustee after the effective date of this
15 amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly.

16 (b) Every voting member of a board under subsection (a) of

1 this Section shall complete a minimum of 4 hours of
2 professional development leadership training covering topics
3 that include, but are not limited to, open meetings law,
4 community college and labor law, freedom of information law,
5 ethics, sexual violence on campus, financial oversight and
6 accountability, audits, and fiduciary responsibilities of a
7 community college trustee during the first, third, and fifth
8 year of his or her term. The community college district shall
9 maintain on its Internet website, if any, the names of all
10 elected or appointed voting trustees of the board who have
11 successfully completed the training, as well as the names of
12 all elected or appointed voting trustees of the board who have
13 not successfully completed the training, as required under this
14 Section.

15 (c) The training under this Section may be provided by an
16 association established under this Code for the purpose of
17 training community college district board trustees or by other
18 qualified providers approved by the State Board, in
19 consultation with an association so established.

20 (d) The board member shall certify completion of the
21 training required under this Section to the secretary of the
22 board. If a board member does not satisfy all requirements
23 provided in subsection (b) of this Section or the certification
24 indicates that a board member has not completed the training,
25 the secretary shall send a notice to all elected or appointed
26 members serving on the board and the president or acting chief

1 executive officer of the community college of that fact.".
