#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Illinois Community College Board, University of Illinois, Southern Illinois University, Chicago State University, Governors State University, Eastern Illinois University, Western Illinois University, Northern Illinois University, Illinois State University, Northeastern Illinois University for various purposes, including for ordinary and contingent expenses. Provides that the appropriation authority is valid for costs incurred from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$35,841,700, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State  
8 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
9 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Chicago State  
12 University Education Improvement Fund to the Board of  
13 Trustees of Chicago State University for any expenses  
14 incurred by the university.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
17 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
18 Chicago State University for costs associated with the  
19 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice  
20 education or training programs.

2 Section 15. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
4 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for Career and  
5 Technical Education Licensed Practical Nurse and Registered  
6 Nurse Preparation.

7 Section 20. The sum of \$60,200, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
9 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for awarding  
10 scholarships to qualifying graduates of the Lincoln's  
11 Challenge Program.

12 Section 25. The sum of \$13,762,200, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
14 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for the City  
15 Colleges of Chicago for educational-related expenses.

16 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much  
17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
18 from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Community  
19 College Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
20 colleges for the purposes specified:

5 Section 35. The sum of \$488,800, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs  
8 associated with the development, support or administration of  
9 the Illinois Longitudinal Data System.

10 Section 40. The sum of \$1,457,900, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
12 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants to  
13 operate the East St. Louis Community College Center.

14 Section 45. In addition to any amounts previously  
15 appropriated, the following named amounts, or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
17 Community College Board for all costs associated with career  
18 and technical education activities:

21 Section 50. The following named amounts, or so much of  
22 those amounts as may be necessary, for the objects and

1 purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois Community  
2 College Board for adult education and literacy activities:

3 From the General Revenue Fund:

6 services to local eligible providers  
7 for adult education and

9 For operational expenses of and

23 Section 55. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
24 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the

1 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College  
 2 Board for distribution to qualifying public community  
 3 colleges for the purposes specified:

5	Equalization Grants .....	<u>73,870,500</u>

7 Section 60. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as  
 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instructional  
 9 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to  
 10 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated  
 11 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

12 Section 65. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the High School  
 14 Equivalency Testing Fund to the Illinois Community College  
 15 Board for costs associated with administering high school  
 16 equivalency tests.

17 Section 70. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof  
 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
 19 Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the  
 20 Illinois Community College Board to be expended under the  
 21 terms and conditions associated with the moneys being  
 22 received, including prior year expenditures.

1 Section 75. The sum of \$480,000, or so much thereof as  
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust  
 3 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and  
 4 contingency expenses of the Board.

5 Section 80. The sum of \$391,000, or so much thereof as  
 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 7 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for a grant to  
 8 Rock Valley College for programs for transitioning high  
 9 school students.

10 Section 85. The sum of \$1,259,300, or so much thereof as  
 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 12 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to reimburse the  
 13 following colleges for costs associated with the Illinois  
 14 Veterans' Grant:

14 Section 5. The sum of \$36,898,800, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
16 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northeastern  
17 Illinois University for ordinary and contingent expenses for  
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

19 ARTICLE 5

20 Section 5. The sum of \$193,317,100, or so much thereof  
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education

1 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois  
2 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

4 Section 10. The sum of \$1,173,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
6 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois  
7 University for all costs associated with the SimmonsCooper  
8 Cancer Center.

9 Section 15. The sum of \$27,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
11 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern  
12 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in  
13 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

14 Section 20. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
16 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
17 Southern Illinois University for all costs associated with  
18 the development, support or administration of pharmacy  
19 practice education or training programs at the Edwardsville  
20 campus.

21 Section 25. The sum of \$68,400, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
2 Fund to the Southern Illinois University for any costs  
3 associated with the Daily Egyptian newspaper.

4 Section 30. The sum of \$311,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention  
6 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University  
7 for costs associated with fire protection services at the  
8 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville campus.

9 ARTICLE 7

10 Section 5. The sum of \$583,024,000, or so much thereof  
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
12 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of University of  
13 Illinois for ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal  
14 year ending June 30, 2016.

15 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much  
16 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
17 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board  
18 of Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet ordinary  
19 and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
20 2016:

6 Section 15. The sum of \$16,447,900, or so much thereof  
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
8 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
9 for costs and expenses related to or in support of the  
10 Prairie Research Institute, in accordance with Public Act 95-  
11 0728.

12 Section 20. The sum of \$43,987,500, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
14 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
15 for operating costs and expenses related to or in support of  
16 the University of Illinois Hospital.

17 Section 25. The sum of \$734,000, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
19 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
20 Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for  
21 Excellence at the Chicago campus.

1           Section 30. The sum of \$301,300, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
3           Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
4           Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

5           Section 35. The sum of \$1,146,800, or so much thereof as  
6           may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
7           Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
8           Illinois for costs associated with the Public Policy  
9           Institute at the Chicago campus.

10          Section 40. The sum of \$321,100, or so much thereof as  
11          may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
12          Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
13          Illinois for a grant to the College of Dentistry.

14          Section 45. The sum of \$3,721,300, or so much thereof as  
15          may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention  
16          Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
17          for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service  
18          Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the  
19          facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment  
20          to the University for personal services and related costs  
21          incurred.

1           Section 50. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as  
2           may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
3           University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
4           University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in  
5           accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

6           Section 55. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
7           may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public  
8           Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and  
9           expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito  
10          Abatement.

11          Section 60. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as  
12          may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire  
13          Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and  
14          expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and  
15          abatement.

16          Section 65. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
17          may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste  
18          Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary  
19          and contingent expenses.

20          Section 70. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
21          may be necessary, is appropriated from the General

1 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
2 University of Illinois for costs associated with the  
3 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice  
4 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at  
5 Rockford.

6 ARTICLE 8

7 Section 5. The sum of \$42,975,700, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
9 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois  
10 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

12 Section 10. The sum of \$21,000, or so much thereof as  
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
14 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern  
15 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in  
16 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

17 ARTICLE 9

18 Section 5. The sum of \$72,226,700, or so much thereof as  
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
20 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Illinois State

1 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
2 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

3 ARTICLE 10

4 Section 5. The sum of \$91,092,700, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
6 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois  
7 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
8 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$36,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
11 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern  
12 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in  
13 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

14 ARTICLE 12

15 Section 5. The sum of \$51,445,200, or so much thereof as  
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
17 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western Illinois  
18 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
19 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.
