Amends the Counties Code. Removes a restriction preventing counties from adjudicating offenses under the Illinois Vehicle Code (or a similar offense that is a traffic regulation governing the movement of vehicles).

AN ACT concerning local government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section
5 5-43010 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/5-43010)

7 Sec. 5-43010. Administrative adjudication of county code violations. Any county may provide by ordinance for a system of 8 9 administrative adjudication of county code violations to the extent permitted by the Illinois Constitution. A "system of 10 administrative adjudication" means the adjudication of any 11 violation of a county ordinance, except for (i) proceedings not 12 within the statutory or the home rule authority of counties; 13 14 and (ii) any offense under the Illinois Vehicle Code (or a 15 similar offense that is a traffic regulation governing the movement of vehicles and except for any reportable offense 16 under Section 6-204 of the Illinois Vehicle Code). 17
