Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof as may
5	be necessary, respectively, for the purposes hereinafter named,
6	are appropriated to the Department of Human Services for Grants-
7	In-Aid and Purchased Care in its various regions pursuant to
8	Sections 3 and 4 of the Community Services Act and the Community
9	Mental Health Act:
10	Payable from the General Revenue Fund:
11	For a grant to the Autism Program for an
12	Autism Diagnosis Education Program
13	for Individuals4,300,000
14	Section 10. The following named amount, or so much thereof
15	as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of
16	Human Services for Payments to Community Providers and
17	Administrative Expenditures, including such Federal funds as
18	are made available by the Federal Government for the
19	following purpose:
20	Payable from Autism Research Checkoff Fund:
21	For costs associated with autism research100,000
22	Payable from Autism Awareness Fund:

- 1 For costs associated with autism awareness100,000
- 2 Section 98. The appropriation authority granted in this
- 3 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through
- 4 June 30, 2016.
- 5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect
