2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing
Section 7-166 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/7-166) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 7-166)

Sec. 7-166. Separation benefits - Eligibility. Separation
benefits shall be payable as hereinafter set forth:

9 separation from the service all 1. Upon of participating municipalities and instrumentalities thereof 10 and participating instrumentalities, any participating 11 employee who, on the date of application for such benefit, 12 is not entitled to a retirement annuity shall be entitled 13 14 to a separation benefit.

separation from 15 2. Upon the service of all 16 participating municipalities and instrumentalities thereof 17 and participating instrumentalities, any participating employee who, on the date of application for such benefit, 18 19 is entitled to a retirement annuity of less than \$100 \$30 20 per month for life may elect to take a separation benefit 21 in lieu of the retirement annuity.

and participating instrumentalities, any participating employee who, on the date of application for such benefit, is entitled to a retirement annuity, but wishes instead to use the amounts to his or her credit in the Fund to purchase credit in another retirement plan, may elect to take a separation benefit in lieu of the retirement annuity.
