2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 3003 on page 1,
3	line 5, by replacing "2.11" with "2.10, 2.11,"; and
4	on page 1, immediately below line 5, by inserting the
5	following:
6	"(520 ILCS 5/2.10) (from Ch. 61, par. 2.10)
7	Sec. 2.10. The Department may, on an annual basis,
8	establish a spring wild turkey open season within the period
9	beginning on March 1 and running through May 31, and a fall
10	wild turkey season within the period beginning on October 1 and
11	running through January 31. The Department may, on an annual
12	basis, establish a youth-only spring wild turkey season which
13	shall include 2 consecutive weekends. It shall be unlawful for
14	any person to take wild turkey without possessing a valid "Wild
15	Turkey Hunting Permit". Persons holding a spring permit may
16	take female wild turkeys with visible beards or male wild

turkeys during the spring open season. Persons holding a fall permit may take turkeys of either sex during the fall open season. The Department shall cause notice of administrative rules setting forth the prescribed rules and regulations, including those counties of the State where open seasons are established, to be given in accordance with Sections 1.3 and 1.13.
