Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

- 6 Section 105. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof
- 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of
- 8 State Police, Division of Administration, from the Wireless
- 9 Carrier Reimbursement Fund for expenses incurred for the
- 10 Statewide 911 Administrator Program.
- 11 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 12 1, 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
- 13 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
