- 4 Section 65. The amount of \$525,000, or so much thereof
- 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 6 Fund to the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority
- 7 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council
- 8 Program.
- 9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 10 2016, if and only if Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
- 11 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
- in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
