ARTICLE 1

14 Section 5. The sum of \$413,000, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Gaming Fund 16 to the Illinois Gaming Board for costs and expenses related 17 to or in support of a Government Services Shared Services 18 Center.
