SB3380

Introduced 3/2/2016, by Sen. William E. Brady

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes various appropriations concerning higher education and the Illinois Math and Science Academy, if and only if Senate Bill 2400 and Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General Assembly become law. Provides that the appropriation authority is valid for costs incurred from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. As used in this Act, "operational expenses"
6 includes the following: personal services; State
7 contributions to social security; State contributions to
8 group insurance; contractual services; travel; commodities;
9 printing; equipment; electronic data processing;
10 telecommunications services; operation of automotive
11 equipment; refunds; employee retirement contributions paid by
12 the employer; permanent improvements; and deposits to other
13 funds.

14 ARTICLE 5

15 Section 5. The sum of \$2,371,100, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
17 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet its operational
18 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

19 Section 10. The sum of \$7,350,900, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for grants and
2 administrative expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,
3 2016.

4 Section 15. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality
6 Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as
7 supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with
8 the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.

9 Section 20. The amount of \$80,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private College
11 Academic Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher
12 Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses
13 associated with the administration and enforcement of 110
14 ILCS 1005.

15 Section 25. The amount of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business
17 and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of
18 Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and
19 expenses associated with the administration and enforcement
20 of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.

21 Section 30. The sum of \$16,983,800, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
2 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Math and Science Academy to
3 meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June
4 30, 2016.

5 Section 35. The sum of \$30,000 or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Distance Learning Fund
7 to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for
8 costs and expenses associated with the administration and
9 enforcement of 110 ILCS 145/40.

ARTICLE 10

11 Section 5. The sum of \$158,653,700, or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
13 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois
14 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

16 Section 10. The sum of \$938,400, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
18 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois
19 University for all costs associated with the SimmonsCooper
20 Cancer Center.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$27,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
3 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern
4 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in
5 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

6 Section 20. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
8 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
9 Southern Illinois University for all costs associated with
10 the development, support or administration of pharmacy
11 practice education or training programs at the Edwardsville
12 campus.

13 Section 25. The sum of \$54,700, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Southern Illinois University for any costs
16 associated with the Daily Egyptian newspaper.

17 Section 30. The sum of \$311,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
19 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University
20 for costs associated with fire protection services at the
21 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville campus.

ARTICLE 15

2 Section 5. The sum of \$467,398,300, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
4 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of University of
5 Illinois for ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal
6 year ending June 30, 2016.

7 Section 10. The sum of \$13,158,300, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
10 for costs and expenses related to or in support of the
11 Prairie Research Institute, in accordance with Public Act 95-
12 0728.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$35,190,000, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
16 for operating costs and expenses related to or in support of
17 the University of Illinois Hospital.

18 Section 20. The sum of \$587,200, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
20 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
21 Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for

1 Excellence at the Chicago campus.

2 Section 25. The sum of \$241,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
4 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
5 Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

6 Section 30. The sum of \$917,400, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
8 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
9 Illinois for costs associated with the Public Policy
10 Institute at the Chicago campus.

11 Section 35. The sum of \$256,900, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
13 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
14 Illinois for a grant to the College of Dentistry.

15 Section 40. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
17 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
18 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
19 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

20 Section 45. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public
2 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
3 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito
4 Abatement.

5 Section 50. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire
7 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
8 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and
9 abatement.

10 Section 55. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste
12 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary
13 and contingent expenses.

14 Section 60. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
16 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
17 University of Illinois for costs associated with the
18 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
19 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at
20 Rockford.

ARTICLE 20

2

Section 5. The sum of \$34,380,600, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
4 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois
5 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
6 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

7

Section 10. The sum of \$8,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
9 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Eastern
10 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in
11 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

ARTICLE 25

13

Section 5. The sum of \$57,781,400, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
15 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Illinois State
16 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

ARTICLE 30

19

Section 5. The sum of \$373,254,500, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
2 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant
3 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program,
4 as provided by law, and for agency administrative and
5 operational costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total
6 appropriation in this Section.

7 Section 10. The sum of \$10,634,800, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
9 Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
10 for grants and administrative expenses for the fiscal year
11 ending June 30, 2016.

12
13 Section 15. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ISAC Accounts
15 Receivable Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
16 for costs associated with the collection of delinquent
17 scholarship awards pursuant to the Illinois State Collection
18 Act of 1986.

19 Section 20. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
21 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
22 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate
23 Program, as provided by law.

1 Section 25. The following named sum, or so much thereof
 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
 3 Student Assistance Commission Contracts and Grants Fund to
 4 the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the following
 5 purpose:

6 To support outreach, research, and
 7 training activities\$10,000,000

8 Section 30. The following named sum, or so much thereof
 9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Optometric
 10 Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the Illinois Student
 11 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

12 Grants and Scholarships
 13 For payment of scholarships for the
 14 Optometric Education Scholarship
 15 Program, as provided by law\$50,000

16 Section 35. The following named sum, or so much thereof
 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the National Guard
 18 and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the Illinois Student
 19 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

20 Grants and Scholarships
 21 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
 22 Naval Militia Scholarships

1 at State-controlled universities
 2 and public community colleges in
 3 Illinois to students eligible to
 4 receive such awards, as provided by law\$20,000

5 Section 40. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as
 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Golden Apple
 7 Scholars of Illinois Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
 8 Commission for the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois Program,
 9 as provided by law.

10 ARTICLE 35

11 Section 5. The sum of \$72,874,200, or so much thereof as
 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
 13 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois
 14 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
 15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

16 Section 10. The sum of \$36,000, or so much thereof as
 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
 18 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northern
 19 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards, in
 20 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

1 ARTICLE 40

2 Section 5. The sum of \$41,156,200, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
4 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western Illinois
5 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
6 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

7 Section 10. The amount of \$20,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
9 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western
10 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards from the
11 sale of collegiate license plates.

12 ARTICLE 45

13 Section 5. The sum of \$28,673,400, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
15 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State
16 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

18 Section 10. The sum of \$1,600,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Chicago State
20 University Education Improvement Fund to the Board of

1 Trustees of Chicago State University for any expenses
2 incurred by the university.

3 Section 15. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
5 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
6 Chicago State University for costs associated with the
7 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
8 education or training programs.

9 Section 20. The sum of \$391,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
11 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State
12 University as a grant to the Financial Assistance Outreach
13 Center.

14 ARTICLE 50

15 Section 5. The sum of \$19,249,700, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
17 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Governors State
18 University for ordinary and contingent expenses for the
19 fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

ARTICLE 55

2 Section 5. The amount of \$1,744,100, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
4 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board to meet its
5 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,
6 2016.

7 Section 10. The amount of \$68,764,200, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for grants and
10 administrative expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,
11 2016.

12 Section 15. The amount of \$234,754,900, or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
14 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Community College
15 Board for grants and administrative expenses for the fiscal
16 year ending June 30, 2016.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from ICCB Instructional
19 Development and Enhancement Applications Revolving Fund to
20 the Illinois Community College Board for costs associated
21 with maintaining and updating instructional technology.

1 Section 25. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the High School
3 Equivalency Testing Fund to the Illinois Community College
4 Board for costs associated with administering high school
5 equivalency tests.

6 Section 30. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
8 Community College Board Contracts and Grants Fund to the
9 Illinois Community College Board to be expended under the
10 terms and conditions associated with the moneys being
11 received.

12 Section 35. The sum of \$480,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the ICCB Federal Trust
14 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for ordinary and
15 contingency expenses of the Board.

16

ARTICLE 60

17 Section 5. The sum of \$29,519,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
19 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Northeastern
20 Illinois University for ordinary and contingent expenses for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.

2 ARTICLE 65

3 Section 5. The amount of \$1,058,600, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
5 Fund to the State Universities Civil Service System to meet
6 its ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year
7 ending June 30, 2016.

8 ARTICLE 998

9 Section 5. The appropriation authority granted in this
10 Act shall be valid for costs incurred July 1, 2015 through
11 June 30, 2016.

12 ARTICLE 999

13 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
14 becoming law; but this Act does not take effect at all unless
15 Senate Bill 2400 and Senate Bill 2789 of the 99th General
16 Assembly become law.
