## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT SC0016

Introduced 7/8/2015, by Sen. Christine Radogno

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new ILCON Art. V, Sec. 2

Proposes to amend the Legislature and Executive Articles of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that a person may not be elected to the office of State Senator or State Representative, or a combination of those offices, for terms totalling more than 10 years; service before the second Wednesday in January of 2017 shall not be considered in the calculation of a person's service. Provides that a person may not be elected to any Executive Branch office, or any combination of Executive Branch offices, for terms totalling more than 8 years; service before the second Monday in January of 2017 shall not be considered in the calculation of a person's service.

12	THE LEGISLATURE
13	(ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new)
14	SECTION 2.5. TERM LIMITS. A person may not be elected to the
15	office of State Senator or State Representative, or a
16	combination of those offices, for terms totalling more than 10
17	years. Service before the second Wednesday in January of 2017
18	shall not be considered in the calculation of a person's
19	service.
20	ARTICLE V
21	THE EXECUTIVE

- 1 (ILCON Art. V, Sec. 2)
- SECTION 2. TERMS 2
- 3 These elected officers of the Executive Branch shall hold 4 office for four years beginning on the second Monday of January
- 5 after their election and, except in the case of the Lieutenant
- 6 Governor, until their successors are qualified. They shall be
- 7 elected at the general election in 1978 and every four years
- 8 thereafter. A person may not be elected to any Executive Branch
- 9 office, or any combination of Executive Branch offices, for
- terms totalling more than 8 years. Service before the second 10
- 11 Monday in January of 2017 shall not be considered in the
- 12 calculation of a person's service.
