WHEREAS, Susan Browning was an active member of the Fish Hook United Brethren Church, where she served as worship leader and as a Sunday school teacher; she also served as Treasurer of the Fairmount Township Sunday School Convention; she was a 20-year member of the Pike County 4-H Foundation Board, which raised money for local 4-H programs, and she was a leader of the Perry 4-H Stitchers Club for 6 years; she liked to travel, sew, craft, and bake and was especially known for her delicious pies; she was also active in State and local politics for the
