13 WHEREAS, Early in his life, Joseph Falotico was a member of Immaculate Conception Church in Waukegan, where he was highly 14 15 involved in the Holy Name Society and Church Choir; he was also a reader, Eucharistic minister, and CCD teacher; he spent many 16 volunteer hours at the VA hospital on Sundays, bringing 17 18 patients to Mass and doing the church readings at St. Therese 19 Chapel as well; he was a Past Grand Knight of the Knights of Columbus Council #731 and #11112, and Past Faithful Navigator 20 21 4th degree Bishop Quarter Assembly; he also cooked dinner for 22 the K of C Bingo volunteers; he was in charge of "Italian

9 WHEREAS, Joseph Falotico was a very active person, keeping 10 up with his large garden to which he always shared the bounty 11 of fruit and veggies from the trunk of his car at church; he 12 opened his trunk when he arrived at church and by the time Mass 13 was over his trunk was empty; he enjoyed keeping up with his yard work and driving his Model "A" cars to shows and on short 14 15 trips; he hosted many picnics at his home throughout the years; 16 and
