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AN ACT concerning insurance.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
adding Section 356z.1 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.1 new)

Sec. 356z.1. Surgical assistants. A group or individual 7 8 policy of accident and health insurance amended, delivered, issued, or renewed after the effective date of this 9 amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly that provides 10 coverage for health care services, including surgical 11 12 services, must provide coverage for services rendered by an 13 assistant in surgery authorized or credentialed by a hospital 14 or ambulatory surgical treatment center to provide surgical assistance to a physician licensed to practice medicine in 15 all its branches. An assistant in surgery may be a physician 16 licensed to practice medicine in all its branches, a 17 18 physician assistant, an advanced practice registered nurse, a registered professional nurse, or a nationally certified 19 surgical assistant or nationally certified first assistant. 20

21 Section 10. The Health Maintenance Organization Act is 22 amended by changing Section 4-6.5 as follows:

Sec. 4-6.5. Required health benefits. A health maintenance organization is subject to the provisions of Sections 356t, and 356u, and 356z.1 of the Illinois Insurance Code.
