AN ACT in relation to contracts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the5 Building and Construction Contract Act.

6 Section 5. Definitions. In this Act:

7 "Building and construction contract" means a contract for 8 the design, construction, alteration, improvement, repair, or 9 maintenance of real property, highways, roads, or bridges.

Section 10. Progress payments and retainages.

(a) Unless a building and construction contract requires otherwise, the owner or other person making payments under the contract must make monthly progress payments. Payments must be based on reasonable estimates of work completed as approved by the owner or the owner's agent. A progress payment is not acceptance of or approval of any work or a waiver of any defects in the work.

(b) An owner or an owner's agent may reserve a retainage from any progress payment of an amount not to exceed 5% of the progress payment. An owner or owner's agent may reduce the amount of the retainage and may eliminate the retainage on any monthly payment if, in the owner's opinion, the work is progressing satisfactorily.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect uponbecoming law.
