AN ACT concerning election of county board members.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section 2-3020 as follows:
(55 ILCS 5/2-3020 new)
Sec. 2-3020. Reduction in the number of county board members. The residents of a county with a board of more than 17 members may petition the county board to reduce the number of members to 17. Upon its receipt of petitions signed by at least $10 \%$ of the registered voters in the county, the county board shall certify the question to the appropriate election authority for submission to the voters of the county at the next election in accordance with the Election Code. The question shall be in substantially the following form:
"Shall the number of commissioners of (insert county name) be decreased from (insert current number of commissioners) to 17?". The votes shall be recorded as "Yes" or "No".

If a majority of votes cast are in the affirmative, the number of county board members shall be reduced to 17 beginning with the next election following the next federal decennial census after the approval of the question as provided in this Section.
